Soccer Complex - The mayor has committed personnel devoted to securing the additional funding needed to finance the project.

Jordan River Parkway Extension - Funding exists to extend the parkway to the county line. The mayor is working to have Davis County finance the final piece of the trail that will connect it with the Legacy Parkway Trail.

I-215 Sound Wall - With increased traffic on the freeway, the mayor is willing to pursue the possibility of working with UDOT to build a sound wall along the freeway.
